




## EXHAUSTED RULER – RON DEVORE

## BOARD OF DIRECTORS REPORT, MAY 2016

Board of Directors Report, June 2016

A nice welcome to our Snowbirds, a lot has happened at the Lodge in the past few months, as you may notice all the Chairs, the Esquire and the Chaplain are Ladies as well as our Secretary and Treasurer. We have been very active, added a Thursday Guest Chef Dinner and our new Officers have done a great job adding new activities. Again we started the year blazing, in April we had the best month in the kitchen ever, already we are over 75% YTD in the RV rental income and the bar doing great and for the first time ever the wine sales surpassed the liquor sales. Overall the Lodge started the year with the same momentum we had last year, our new ER Ron Devore has a full schedule of activities throughout the year. We are contemplating how we could build an outdoor cover area for cooking; we have an opportunity to get the steak grill from the Aberdeen Lodge, this grill is about 5' long and will not fit in our kitchen. This year our Loyal Knight Katie Miller is our ENF Chair and also Grants Coordinator, I will be working with her and make sure we are ready to go on July 1<sup>st</sup>. As I told you last month, we had an extraordinary water bill due to an accident in the RV area; it was reduced from \$6,100.00 to \$1,900.00 and we paid last month and as I asked you last month if you are able to donate any amount to amortize this expense we appreciate it. The Lodge has been very active with local groups, Answers for All every Wednesday, Toastmasters every Thursday evening, Ocean Shores Park Board 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday, Interpretive Center 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday and a couple more. Again this year we will have the Youth Golf Camp in June, July and August; this is through an ENF Grant, and we will be asking for Volunteers to help with the Kids. Our next BOD meetings will be on Monday June 6th at 4:00pm and remember is open to all Lodge Members, this is your Lodge and we are your representatives; if you have any ideas or suggestions for the Board please come to the meetings and let us know, we want to hear from you. Again thanks to all our members for their continued support and big thanks to all the Volunteers for a Fantastic Job.



## PADDLEWHEEL GAME RULES

3. Paddles are to be collected after each game and cannot be kept by the players.


