

PADDLEWHEEL GAME RULES

- 1. There will be five games minimum to ten games maximum each scheduled game night.
- 2. Paddles are 2 for \$1.00, Bonus round paddles \$0.25 ea.
- 3. Paddles are to be collected after each game and cannot be kept by the players.
- 4. Paddles need to be counted after each round.
- No player is to intentionally hang on to the paddles or they will be excused from playing further games that night.
- 6. Winners of the alcohol must sign for the prize immediately and may collect their prize at the end of the game night from the game host. All bottles are to be taken off of Elks property or given to the bartender until the winner decides to leave the Elks for the evening.
- 7. Elks that do not drink alcohol but want to play may exchange the alcohol for a free regular Thursday night dinner ticket for 2 people.
- 8. Do NOT intentionally break the paddles because the game will have to be delayed as the officials make new paddles.
- 9. Do NOT deface or mark the paddles to give anyone an unfair advantage of winning.
- 10. Winner sheets will remain in storage for a minimum of two years for auditing purposes.
- 11. Monies collected from the game night are tallied and will be placed in the Elks charities programs per the board and officers.
